



- Limited file transfer options FTP



Adoption will continue to advance rapidly due to:


- Implementation of the Adobe Print Engine by vendors

PDF File Format - Benefits


- Exchangeable file format
- 'Preview'-able
- Editable
- Predictable
- Resolution independent
- Minimal file size
- Internet compatible
- Facilitates Automation

 - Compares both raster and vector objects for differences
 - Creates a separate PDF file which can be shared with customers


• The path to automation within a packaging workflow


